He has over twenty years professional experience in the public local government and in management of public local enterprises providing services of general interest.

In the past years he has also been deeply involved in the fields of social dialogue, socio-territorial cohesion and environmental policies.

Since 2009 he is President of Herambiente Spa, the largest Italian waste company. Herambiente is part of Hera Group, a multi-utility company listed in the Milan stock exchange.

Since March 2010 he is Executive Vice-President of CEEP (European Centre of Employers and Enterprises Providing Public Services), where he is fully engaged in the CEEP CSR Label promoting Corporate Social Responsibility in public services since 2008.

In April 2014 he has been elected President of Federambiente, the national association representing over 200 Italian waste companies. Since June 2015 Federambiente and Federutility (Italian federation of energy and water companies) merged creating the new association Utilitalia, representative of the whole sector of the Italian industrially relevant local public services. Therefore he now is Deputy Vice-President of the new federation.

Since September 2014 he is Deputy President of CEWEP.

He is also Chairman of Enomondo Srl (a joint venture between Herambiente and Caviro) and Vice-President of Fea Srl (subsidiary that manages the Bologna WTE).

Utilitalia (formerly Federambiente) is the Italian member of MWE (Municipal Waste Europe).
